- Responds to patient emergencies in the clinical setting and arrange transportation for more serious injuries
- Works closely with the Site Safety Manager and Site Manager

- Conducts CPR and first aid training (as and when necessary)
- Ensures effective and efficient implementation of company rules and regulation, quality policies, system and procedures
- Stores, administers and monitors first aid treatments on injuries, accidents and other health related issues
- Prepares report on maintenance of accurate nursing and medical records and up to date client's case notes
- Monitors subcontractor's first-aid kit
- Assists the emergency response of the project site
- Attends consultations of workers and employees on site
- Keeps documentation of medical records
- Participates on site's emergency response drills
- Is accountable for adequacy of medical stock
- Is accountable for HSE status of the site's clinic (procedures, housekeeping, warning signs, proper disposal)
